Dear Valued Stallholder,

With Xmas getting closer, this year we are **DEFINITELY** only doing **ONE DECEMBER Market on the THIRD Sunday, DEC 20TH** & only **ONE in JANUARY**. Book in early please!!

With the amount of stallholders now wanting to come to the Yamba River Markets, all regular stallholders need to be reminded that if they **miss THREE markets in a row** they **lose their permanent site** and go back to being casuals. Our crystal balls only work so far so please keep in touch with us regarding your changes in attendance.

We will continue to collect the stall fees first thing in the morning in the queues so please have your rent money ready. If you wish to pay for your site in advance (**FOR REGULARS ONLY**) & avoid the line-up, do so at the Market Info Stall on the day. **Do not lose your Receipt!** You will not be allowed on the Market site next month without it. We will run this on a trial basis at first.

When booking in, making market enquiries or passing our contact information on to new stallholders **please use the phone times listed above**. As we are volunteer market organisers these times are important to us so please respect them.

If you end up with a lot of clean empty cardboard boxes when the market is over, please do not jam them into the garbage bins – flatten & stack them tidily behind your stall site for us to collect afterwards. Finally **a BIG thank you to ALL the stallholders** who have abided by the No Plastic Bags rule willingly. Your continued support is greatly appreciated.

Things to remember:

The following rules have been made by the Clarence Valley Council, which we are obliged to abide by. We ask that you help us to implement these:

1. **No Plastic Bags** – This is to protect the local fishing industry, nearby foreshores and native wildlife.
2. **No cars on site before 6:30am** and **PLEASE** do not leave the markets before 2pm.
3. **All electrical appliances and leads must be tagged by a licensed electrician or registered electrical tester and tagger.**

YAMBA RIVER MARKETS - PRICE LIST

We are aiming to make the inner section of the markets car free for better use of the limited space we have as well as for safety, logistical & aesthetic reasons. Do please consider unloading your vehicle and then parking it nearby and saving \$5 dollars in the process.

Standard site 4mx4m Cost = \$ 25

Larger Stall Site prices are determined by a *per metre frontage* charge of \$5 per extra metre beyond 4m.

Eg: A 6m x 4m Stall Site = The Standard Site Cost + 2 extra metres = \$35

Extra Charges:

- There is still an initial **Registration Fee** of **\$5**. All first-time stallholders must pay this charge. To avoid this fee a second time, please keep us regularly informed of your market attendance plans.
- **Vehicle Fee's** remain at **\$5** for **one** Vehicle (car/ute/truck) \$5 will be charged for each additional vehicle at the stall site. There will be no charge for trailers, caravans, boats or novelty vehicles.
- Please remember that there are plenty of free stallholder car parking spaces at the bottom end of the Market. Be respectful of the nearby residents back yards when parking your vehicles
- **Electricity Fee's** - **\$10** for the first lead then **\$20** for each additional lead so please consider your electrical requirements carefully.
- **Insured Sites** cost an extra **\$10** each (we can only provide a limited amount of insured sites so please obtain your own if you are planning to be regular) All stallholders **must** have proof of current P/L insurance.

Other:

- There are only a limited number of **½ stalls** (2m x 2m) sites available. No gazebos or vehicles are allowed with this option.
- **Maximum depth** is 4m. We have a limited number of sites with extra depth. Please request this when booking.
- **Food stalls** operate on separate rates, please contact us for a quote.
